It is a great honour and pleasure to welcome you to the second edition of the Proceedings of the Mongolian Academy of Sciences (PMAS) in 2023 for which I have worked as the chief editor.

The PMAS is the only peer review journal in Mongolia that publishes results from all areas of different scientific disciplines, including natural, social and technical sciences. We have also applied for inclusion into the Elsevier Scopus database platform. Moreover, our journal has been granted 2 stars by the Journal Publishing and Practices Standards (JPPS). In the journal you can now see the list of databases in which our journal has been recorded.

This year's issue comprised papers covering topics from characterising the paradigm in policy, impacts of natural and human factors on soil erosion, the effects of copper mining on vegetation disturbances, directions for the use of various types of waste, modern trends of development in lake research, non-organic sleep disorders and sleep quality, and body structure, and operation features of athletes study. We sincerely hope that you will find new and useful information from the papers that are being published herein.

Finally, I would like to sincerely thank our team, including editor Enkhamgalan Damiran, Burenbayar Chanrav, Odongarav Nayanjin and Gantulga Lkhagva for the highly effective efforts to improve the quality and content of the journal and to make it widely accessible. My thanks also go to many others who have substantially contributed to the development of our journal's reputation, including the Editorial Board members, reviewers, authors and readers.
